

## 4<sup>th</sup> Grade ELA

Reading points are earned on multiple-choice questions that measure Common Core Reading and Language Standards. Writing from Sources points are earned on short- and extended-response questions that measure Common Core Reading, Language and Writing Standards.

### English Language Arts Common Core Standards

#### **Reading**

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**Number of Possible Points**

Students comprehend the key ideas and details present in grade-level text, recognizing how details support plot development, describe characters in depth, and connect ideas and events. Students also determine the meaning of words and phrases as used in the text, understand how the text is organized, and compare and contrast different points of view. Additionally, students integrate the knowledge and ideas conveyed in text using illustrations and logical connections between parts of the text.

#### **Writing from Sources**

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Students generalize place-value understanding for multi-digit whole numbers, recognizing that in a multi-digit whole number a digit in one place represents ten times what it represents in the place to its right. Students read and write multi-digit whole numbers using base-ten numerals, number names, and expanded form, and use place-value understanding to round multi-digit whole numbers to any place.
